Crail Workshops

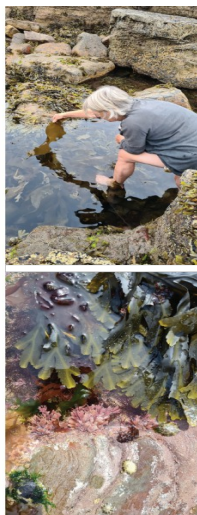
